I am sure all of you are now getting ready for the year end activities. Let me take this opportunity to wish you good luck, happiness and prosperity always.

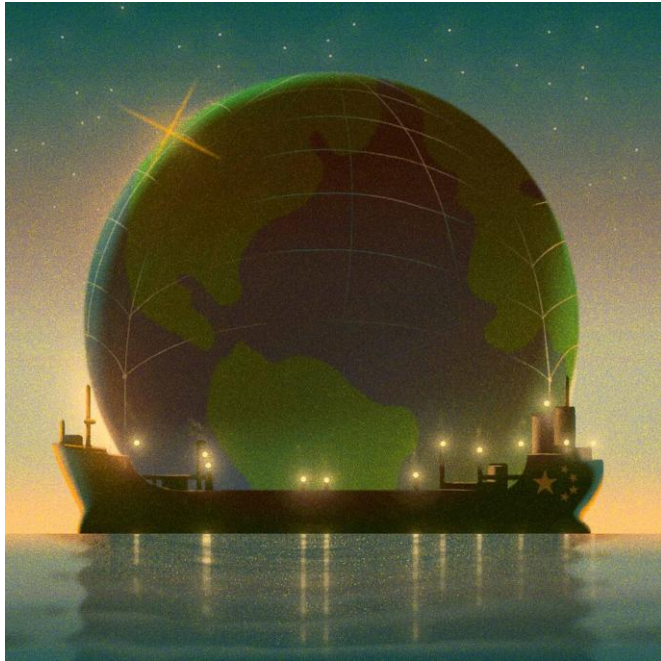

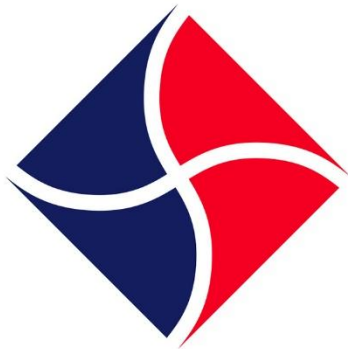
